LADIES LUNCH


The ladies lunch is being planned for Tuesday, September 18 at noon. The location will be in next week's bulletin.

NEEDS OF HUSBANDS AND WIVES

Marriage is hard work - like anything else. A good marriage is forged, not merely formed. God made woman to fulfill the need of lonely Adam. In making marriage He also revealed what both men and women need (Ephesians 5:22-23).

- 1. Women are to reverence their husbands. The buzz word in pop Psychology today is **Self Esteem**. There is much truth in this. Men can have **Good Esteem** or **Poor Esteem**. When husbands know their wives respect them profoundly, they can lick the world. This is why nagging, nit-picking, put downs, griping, criticizing, from wives to husbands is catastrophic. When two mates are becoming one they no longer live/think solo. Respect in the Bible means the controlling motive in life. Peter even observed that unbelieving husbands could be converted by the chaste respect of their wives.
- 2. Husbands are to love their wives as Christ loved the church. Women wish to be loved, to be considered. Paul further adds, "Nourished and cherished." To nourish is to bring to full maturity. Husbands seek the best for their wives. To cherish is to create a warm atmosphere. To be gentle, thoughtful, kind, and attentive. Husbands are to treat their wives like they are "10's."

Women! Encourage, support, pray for your husbands! Be proud of them. Husbands! Die for your wives. . . Serve them. A husband that will die for his wife will be respected by that wife.

CHANGE! The only person I can change is myself. Wives! Change yourselves! Husbands! Change yourselves! Do not try to blame/change others. Change yourselves. Having a big house is worthless if it is not a home. Make that life-time commitment to be that mate that can help produce a great home. Don't be **Married Singles**! Be partners, not roommates.

"But (if) we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin" (1 John 1:7).

Do you want God's goodness and favor?

"Therefore consider the goodness and severity of God: on those who fell, severity; but toward you, goodness, (if) you continue in His goodness. Otherwise you also will be cut off" (Romans 11:22).

Do you want to be known by God?

"And (if) anyone thinks that he knows anything, he knows nothing yet as he ought to know" (1 Corinthians 8:2).

Do you want to be a new creation?

"Therefore, (if) anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new" (2 Corinthians 5:17).

Do you want to avoid being destroyed by God?

"(If) anyone defiles the temple of God, God will destroy him. For the temple of God is holy, which temple you are" (1 Corinthians 3:17).

Do you want to go to Heaven?

"But also for this very reason, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue, to virtue knowledge, to knowledge self-control, to self-control perseverance, to perseverance godliness, to godliness brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness love. For (if) these things are yours and abound, you will be neither barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ...sure, for (if) you do these things you will never stumble; for so an entrance will be supplied to you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ" (2 Peter 1:5-11).

Though just a two letter word, **"if**" will determine the success or failure of our lives here on earth, as well as throughout eternity. And that makes "**if**" a pretty big word!
