## DANA'S DIRECTION

## "God's Word and the Christian."

There are probably few aspects of Christian living that we talk about more and practice less than meaningful study of the Bible. We surely believe that the Bible is the inspired word of God and would vigorously challenge anyone who denies it. We accept that it is the source of authority and insist that everything we believe and practice in our faith be according to scripture. We believe in the Bible! Unfortunately, many Christians spend little time reading, studying and learning what is written there.

There was a time when even average members of the church were known for their knowledge of scripture. Years ago, I knew a Christian man whose humble occupation was that of a custodian/greeter at a furniture store. His Bible was his constant companion. For more than forty years he capably taught the adult Bible class in the congregation that he attended. Someone once commented, "I would give half my life to know the Bible like you do." "That's what it has taken me," was his reply.

It is the sad truth that the majority of Christians today give very little effort to the study of God's word. For many, the only time their Bible is used is in class on Sunday morning and Wednesday nights. In fact, many Bibles never leave the car in between! If we would only realize what we are missing! God has provided a spiritual feast for us in His word – and we are starving!

To benefit from God's word, we absolutely must immerse ourselves in it. The Christians of Berea were said to be noble because they "received the word with all readiness, and searched the Scriptures daily." (Acts 17:11) All of us know that we must eat every day to be nourished physically. Why would our spiritual needs be any less important?

The Psalmist wrote "Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the path of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful: but his delight is in the law of the Lord, and in His law he meditates day and night." (Psalm 1:1-2). What are some of the benefits that Christians derive from sincere and dedicated study of God's word?

"Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. (Romans 10:17) The scriptures make us "wise unto <u>salvation</u>." (Il Timothy 3:15) When we "receive with meekness the implanted word," it is able to save our souls. (James 1:21) The word of God will <u>keep us from sin</u>. "How can a young man cleanse his way?" By taking heed to God's word. (Psalm 119:9)

God, through His commandments, <u>makes us wiser</u> than our enemies and <u>gives us more understanding</u> than our teachers. (Psalm 119:98-99) The things written in the Bible were "written for our learning, that we through the <u>patience</u> and <u>comfort</u> of the Scriptures might have hope." (Romans 15:4) Jesus said "You shall <u>know the truth</u> and the truth shall <u>make you free</u>." (John 8:32) Knowing God's word keeps us safe from false teachers who would lead us astray. If, however, we do not have a love of the truth, we will end up believing a lie – and be condemned. (II Thessalonians 2:10-12)

We must "study to <u>show ourselves</u> <u>approved unto God</u>, a workman who needs not be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." (II Timothy 2:15) A knowledge of God's word <u>equips</u> <u>us for every good work</u> (II Tim.3:17), preparing us to <u>give an answer</u> to everyone who asks us the reason of the hope that is within us." (I Peter 3:15)

We are told to "hunger and thirst after righteousness," and to "let the words of Christ dwell in us richly." Paul was frustrated that the Corinthians could not receive the things he wanted to teach them because they remained babes, still feeding on the milk of the word. (I Corinthians 3:1-2) How frustrated God must get with us. God has provided all the teaching, instruction and guidance needed in our Christian lives – and we ignore what He has written! The only way God can speak to us is in His word – we need to listen to Him, we need to study our Bibles, every day.


