

# DANA'S DIRECTION

"Watch your eyes, your ears, your lips, your hands, your feet"







When I was growing up, I loved the things at church that were done for children; the Bible classes, pew-packers, VBS, and Christian youth camp. It is amazing that after all these years I can still remember so much about my teachers and the lessons we were taught. I especially loved to sing and I can remember most of the songs. One of my favorite (probably because of the hand motions) was "There's a Father up above." It was admonition to remember that whatever we think or do, God is watching! It is still important for Christians to watch our eyes, our ears, our lips, our hands, and our feet!

Watch your eyes, what they see. In the times we are living this takes constant diligence! The "lust of the eyes" (I John 2:16) is one of Satan's primary weapons against us. Though movies, television, and the internet we are bombarded by images intended to create lust within us. We need, like Job to "make a covenant with my eyes" not to. (Job 31:1)

Watch your ears, what they hear. Gossip and tale bearing is a scourge among people, especially in the church. One of the things God hates is the sowing of discord among brethren. (Proverbs 6:19) Don't participate in gossip by lending an ear! (Proverbs 20:19)

Watch your lips, what they say. There are more warnings about the misuse of the tongue in scripture than nearly any other thing, because, as James says "for we all stumble in many things, if anyone does not stumble in word, he is a perfect man, able also to bridle the whole body." (James 3:2) We must be on guard against lies, gossip, harsh unloving criticism, and corrupt communication. Jesus said "for every idle word men may speak, they will give account of it in the day of judgment." (Matthew 12:36-37)

Watch your hands, what they do. We are all tempted to follow after the lusts of our flesh and our eyes, by doing things that are contrary to God's will. We all have the choice of using our time, and talents, and physical strength selfishly serving our flesh or devotedly serving God. Paul said "Do not present your members (bodies) as instruments of sin . . . but as instruments of righteousness to God." (Romans 6:13)

Watch your feet, where they go. We are warned not to "follow the crowd" when the crowd is doing wrong. (Exodus 23:2) As Christians we should be aware not only of the temptations of being in places where evil behavior is taking place, but also the effect that it will have on our influence and reputation. Even worldly people know what kind of behavior a Christian should and should not engage in. As Christians we are told "abstain from every appearance of evil." (I Thessalonians 5:22)

Our motive for watching our eyes, our ears, our lips, our hands, and our feet? "There's a Father up above, looking down in tender love," and we want to do those things that are pleasing to Him. (I John 3:22) Solomon teaches a similar lesson:

"Keep your heart with all diligence, for out of it spring the issues of life. Put away from you a deceitful mouth, and put perverse lips far from you. Let your eyes look straight ahead, and your eyelids look right before you. Ponder the path of your feet...do not turn to the right or the left; remove your foot from evil." (Proverbs 4:23-27)




Life Chain 2016
