
Minute of Meditation Heard on 910 AM WLTP

An article in National Geographic some years ago showed an amazing demonstration of God's love and care. After a forest fire in Yellowstone National Park, rangers began trekking up the mountain to assess the damage. One ranger found a bird literally petrified into ashes perched on the ground at the base of a tree. When he knocked over the bird with a stick, three tiny chicks scurried from under their dead mother's wings. The mother bird had carried her offspring to the base of the tree and gathered them under her wings, willingly giving her life so that her babies could live. God placed that instinct in her. She withstood the flames, protecting those given to her care.
