

Tonk Talk by Mark T. Tonkery

What if I have no Mother or I am not a Mother on Mother's Day?

As joyful and wonderful the thought of having a mother and being a mother is, I am reminded that there are many people who do not share this blessing. Some have had mothers pass away, others have been abandoned by them, or for some reason do not have a relationship with their mother. Then on the other hand some women desperately want to be mothers but for many reasons are not able to have biological children of their own and may not be able to adopt. How can these women and children find a way to meet the need of a mother or the need of being a mother? I am not sure of all the answers but maybe the following can help:

One day in 1960 Nolan McDougal was driving in San Diego when he suffered an aneurysm... and died behind the wheel. His 1959 Lincoln Continental jumped the curb and headed straight toward a crowd of people standing outside a fast-food restaurant. Everybody scattered except one man who froze. The big car struck him, making him the second casualty of the bizarre accident.

The man killed by Nolan McDougal's car was a school teacher and a father of three young children. His wife did not work, and they had no life insurance. The wife filed a claim with McDougal's insurance company, but-unbelievably-they turned it down. Reason: McDougal was already dead when he hit her husband, and therefore it was an "act of God." The grieving widow never contested the company's decision.

When McDougal's wife, now a widow herself, heard that the poor woman would not be getting any insurance money, she contacted her and offered to help in an unusual way. How? By sending her a check to cover the expenses of raising her children...every month until, they graduated from high school. And when they graduated, she offered to pay for their college tuition (one child took the offer and went for four years and graduated). The story never made the news, and a young man named Rad who was helped by Dorothy McDougal, himself never even knowing about it until his aunt passed away in 1985. Ever since then, he says, he's called her "My Sainted Aunt Dorothy."

In a moment of despair and heartache Dorothy McDougal became an "aunt" or "mother" to this family. The Apostle Paul reminds us that even when there is a person in our life who has nurtured, cared for, and has loved us even though she is not our biological mother we are still to honor her just as if she was our mother, notice, Rom 16:13, "Greet Rufus, chosen in the Lord; also his mother, who has been a mother to me as well." Rufus' mother acted as a mother to Paul. We say of a person of this character, that she is a motherly woman. Has there been a "motherly woman" in your life? For Rad it was Dorothy. This passage in Romans is also a reminder that we can be a "mother" to someone who is without a mother or a "child" to a person who is without a child.

As Pr. 23:25 reminds, "Let your father and mother be glad; let her who bore you rejoice." Let's rejoice with our mothers and those "adopted" mothers today and every day by showing her appreciation, and living in such a way that we make our mothers and those who have nurtured and loved us rejoice! *Happy Mother's Day!* Mark T.
