Promises Kept

Fifteen years ago today something incredibly significant happened in my life. It was March 13, 2004 and it was a beautiful day. More importantly, a beautiful girl was walking down the aisle, soon to pledge her faithfulness to me for as long as we both shall live. This was a faithfulness that was to extend through sickness and health, through riches and poverty, and through good times and bad. I could tell as she made that promise she meant every word she said. "He who finds a wife finds what is good and receives favor from the Lord" (Proverbs 18:22). Who am I that God would bless me with such an incredible blessing? I'm still amazed today.

Fifteen years later we are still together. Raeanne has been with me through a ministry in Ohio, a ministry in Michigan, and now as we begin a ministry in West Virginia. She has supported me in many ways throughout all these years – everything from bulletin creation to navigational help. Lots and lots of navigational help. She has kept all the promises she made to me on the day we put rings on each other's fingers. There is no doubt in my mind that these promises will continue to be kept until the end of our lives on this earth. You have got to love those Christian girls who respect the Word of the Lord!

I cannot begin to tell all of you what this kind of faithfulness has meant to me. I cannot even imagine the burden that would be created when this faithfulness doesn't exist. So this is my plea – if you aren't married hold out for someone who loves the Lord. (And love the Lord yourself so that someone will also want to marry you.) If you are married be someone who keeps their word. Once the command for making pledges to the Lord was "When a man makes a vow to the Lord or takes an oath to obligate himself by a pledge, he must not break his word but must do everything he said" (Numbers 30:2). I cannot imagine that pledges made before Christ are to be any less binding. If we pledge ourselves to one another let us keep our pledge! Then surely we will receive favor from the Lord.
