

Ideas on How We Can Use

House to House, Heart to Heart (HTH) Magazine

In this week's bulletin you will find the House to House Heart to Heart Magazine. It comes every two months and is mailed out to select mail routes in the area, as well as coming to the church building. The follow are some good reminders how we might use this gospel paper to reach the lost and encourage the family of God.

- 1. Read HTH and answer the Bible questions in each issue.
- 2. Be ready to talk about HTH and answer any questions people who receive it may have.
- 3. Place HTH in your workplace lounge area for people to take and read.
- 4. Pass HTH on to your friends and family.
- 5. Bible class teachers can use the articles and illustrations in HTH in your Bible class (When Bible classes open again).
- 6. Couples and families can read HTH in family devotionals and use for personal Bible study.
- 7. Take HTH with you when you visit people in their home or in the hospitals and leave it with them to read.
- 8. You can leave HTH in hospital waiting rooms, doctors' offices, truck stops, or other places for people to pick up and take.
- 9. Mail HTH out to your friends, family members, those in prison, or who live far away. (Just make sure you use correct postage).
- 10. Go door-to-door and hand out HTH in your neighborhood on mail routes the church has not mailed to.
- 11. Don't forget to PRAY to the Lord of Harvest for a greater harvest!

Doug's Discussion

Keep Wisdom in View

Focused people are more effective people. There are things that God put us on this green earth to do. Is that where your mind is? On the tasks and opportunities that God has given? Right now I think my mission is pretty clear. God wants me to love my wife. He wants me to raise my kids in the Lord. God wants me to preach sometimes and do youth activities and find Bible class teachers (I still need lots – call me). I believe these to be the tasks God has set before me right now. May these things be what I focus on! What has God given you to do? Have you kept His mission in view? I think that would be wise. "A discerning man keeps wisdom in view, but a fool's eyes wander to the ends of the earth" (Proverbs 17:44).

The truth is that people often have a problem with contentment. Instead of being focused on what is before us, our minds wander to what we think might be the "next best thing." But, as Solomon puts it, "Better what the eye sees than the roaming of the appetite. This too is meaningless, a chasing after the wind" (Ecclesiastes 6:9). Consider how wonderfully God has blessed you! Think about the great opportunities you have to bring glory to the Lord! And if you don't you're likely to start thinking about what your neighbor has and how you like his better. Perhaps you'll begin to envy some of the "freedoms" of the wicked. Maybe your eyes, as you fruitlessly seek pleasure and meaning, will wander to the ends of the earth. If they do you have lost your wisdom.

The moment you're in and the place you are is special. God has provided it. His hope is that you will enjoy your blessings, focus on your mission, and keep your heart on Him. This is the way of wisdom. There are other ways. Endlessly trying to get rich. Unfaithfulness in marriage. Laziness brought on by vain fantasy. There are all kinds of ways to mess up when you live an unfocused, undisciplined life. So I encourage all of you to keep your eyes on God. He is the source of wisdom and the giver of every good thing. No good comes from wandering eyes and hearts.



Rules for Happy Living

Do you desire a "Happy Life"? Follow these rules and you will enjoy happiness that cannot be found in "things" of this world.

- 1. Count your blessings, not your troubles.

 Though we have many problems in life, we are still richly blessed. The plaque on the wall stated, "I grumbled and complained because I had no shoes, until I saw a man who had no feet."
- 2. Live one day at a time. Regardless of what Satan may throw at you, it can be handled "one day at a time" (James 4:13-15). You can control and conquer if you will take on obstacles one day at a time.
- 3. Learn to say, "I love you" to those near and dear. Break the shackles and learned restraints and express your love and appreciation to as many as possible each day. (Mark 14:3-6).
- 4. Be a giver, not a getter. Often if you fail to get out of life what you want, it is because you are expecting to GET instead of GIVE (Luke 6:38).
- 5. Seek good in everyone and everything. Be a "good" seeker. Try hard not to be a "fault finder". When faults are present, deal with them lovingly.
- 6. **Pray every day**. Always take the time to express to God our appreciation for blessings and ask Him for guidance (Luke 18:1).
- 7. **Do a good deed each day.** The "grandest intention" is not as good as the "smallest deed." Follow the Lord's example (Acts 10:38).
- 8. Watch your priorities. Keep the important things in first place (Matt. 6:33).
- 9. **Fill your life with good.** Throw away the "trash" from your life and replace it with good thoughts and deeds (Phil. 4:8).
- 10. Laugh and cry. Laughter is good medicine. A good sense of humor overcomes many "ills and problems" of life.
- 11.Learn to practice the happiness habit. Smile, and the world will smile with you (Phil. 4:4). Make up your mind to "be happy".
- 12. Let go and let God control your life. To find peace and happiness, you must let God completely reign on the throne in your life. You must totally follow His will. It is for your own good.
