Doug's Discussion

How to Turn Away Wrath

Everybody makes mistakes. Not everyone responds to mistakes in the same way. As something of an expert on mistake-making I can tell you that some responses work much better than others. Picture this scenario: you fail in some way at work. Your boss, with an extremely angry look on his face, is heading your direction. There's a few ways you can go with this one. One: you could "remember" that you have somewhere else you really need to be. You left the stove on, right? The red-faced supervisor gets to your desk to find you're not there. Two: you could prepare for war. "If he shouts at me he's going to regret it!" You take mental inventory of every negative thing you have ever thought about your boss or your job and you get ready to send those verbal missiles on their way. Three: you could take a deep breath and deal with the situation humbly and calmly.


I want to suggest that there's a right answer here. Yes, it might be the answer that is least appealing at the time, but the results will make up for it. Do you really want to go home and tell your spouse that you lost your job because you couldn't keep your temper? Or because you panicked? Listen to some wisdom from God: "If a ruler's anger rises against you, do not leave your post; calmness can lay great errors to rest" (Ecclesiastes 10:4). There is no way that you can do anything error free. You're not God. But you can follow God's instructions. Okay, you failed. Get back up and try again. If someone calls you out on it keep your temper in check. "Yes, I know I could have done better. I'm open to any help so I can do better next time. I'm sorry I let you down." Do you know the power of these words - especially if they are sincere? They can help everyone move on from a bad situation.

There are some fights that go on and on, with all kinds of damage on both sides, simply because no one is able or willing to step up and be the bigger person. You don't have to treat others a certain way just because that's how they treat you. I would prefer a boss that doesn't yell – sure. But you don't always get one of those. You do, however, always have the choice of how you respond. "A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger" (Proverbs 15:1). Whether the wrath is deserved or undeserved I encourage you to respond well. One humble and gentle answer could be the end of it.


