Doug's Discussion

The Way of the Fool is Hard

One of the measures of a person's wisdom is what it takes to correct them. Parents of multiple children are going to know what I'm talking about. With some kids wrongdoing can be corrected by a word . . . maybe even just a look. Others require Mr. Pow Pow. (You figure it out.) And then there are the rare cases who can encounter Mr. Pow Pow ten times a day and still refuse to change their ways. We can only hope this is just a phase! We can only hope wisdom is gained – wisdom that is demonstrated by the ability to listen to constructive criticism. "A rebuke impresses a man of discernment more than a hundred lashes a fool" (Proverbs 17:10).

I can't help but think that one of these options is more painful than the other. I would much rather have the rebuke than the hundred lashes. Or even one lash. However, it is not a matter of what I prefer, but of what my stubbornness requires. If I'm willing to listen to the word of correction then I don't need the lashes. But, unfortunately, I'm not always that wise. Sometimes it takes a little more to get my attention. Hopefully I never get to the



point where nothing will get my attention – that's a terrible place to be! God once spoke to the people of Israel through Isaiah and said "Why should you be beaten anymore? Why do you persist in rebellion? Your whole head is injured, your whole heart afflicted" (Isaiah 1:5). God says I correct and you're just not listening. Your sinful deeds are bringing you pain and you still persist. Why continue in the way that leads to destruction?

I feel bad for those who lack wisdom. When I see a child going nuts in the supermarket I'm mumbling to myself "kid . . . that's not the way to go. You're making your life difficult!" When I see someone ignore the correction of a teacher my eyebrows raise. When I see people ignore and reject the Word of God I can only shake my head. May we all find wisdom! May our hearts soften! Soft clay can be molded into the proper shape easily but the harder it gets the more painful and broken the process. So it is with us. The easy way is to be wise. "See to it that you do not refuse him who speaks" (Hebrews 12:25). Listen to those who speak what is right and correct yourself. Listen when God shows you the right way through Jesus Christ. Or . . . you can have a much more difficult and painful life.
