Tonk Talk by Mark T. Tonkery

How washing your hands is a proof that the Bible is from God!

How many times have you been reminded to wash your hands? Only about 100 to 200 times a day. (O.k. maybe that is a little exaggerated). But with the Covid pandemic, one of the ways to help us to avoid getting this virus, as well as other viruses is to wash our hands. It is interesting to note that washing of the hands for hygiene purposes has only been popular since the mid-19th Century.

It was Ignaz Semmelweis, a Hungarian physician who observed and did research and concluded that hand washing was not only good hygiene, but it could save lives by preventing the spread of germs from one patient to another. At first, he was laughed out of his profession but in time, only after his death, others began to see the benefits and even realized that lives were saved by good hand hygiene.

What is even more amazing is that the Bible had been telling people since the time of Moses that washing after one was exposed to blood and other bodily fluids were beneficial. In fact, during the Black Death of the 14th Century, many of the Jews survived because of their hygiene, as taught in the Old Testament.

So, good hygiene saves lives and slows the spread of disease, so how does this prove that the Bible is from God. Well, many of the laws about hygiene are mentioned in the books of the Law of Moses. For example, Leviticus chapters 13-15 teaches the importance of washing after an issue of blood, quarantine a person with various diseases (quarantine also is not a new idea), cleaning houses, and other personal items. In Deuteronomy 23:12-14 we see the instructions to bury human waste, and in Numbers 19:5-22 even one's clothes were to be burned along with washing one's self after coming in contact with a deceased person or animal.

Here is the Bible proof, this knowledge of cleanliness did not come from human innovation; the common knowledge of the day of the other nations that were the neighbors of the Israelites were that disease came from spirits that lived in the blood, there were no hygiene requirements nor did anyone ever recognize there was a problem with germs. This was the popular view until the 1840s when Ignaz Semmelweis realized that disease was spread from one person to another because one did not wash their hands.

So, where did the Israelites get this information, to wash, and to have good hygiene? From knowledge above human knowledge, Almighty God. Remember the laws that God gave Israel in the Old Testament were not just about how to worship, but how to live civil and healthy lives as well, in-

cluding good hygiene. This would have been one-way Israel would have been set apart from the other nations and it would have pointed to the Lord God sharing His knowledge with humans on how to live best in this world.

This whole hand washing thing originated with God, so wash your hands, it might save a life, even yours. Even more important it is a reminder that God truly cares for us and His wisdom is so much greater than ours. Think about it!

God Has Made It Plain

Isn't it interesting how easily children believe in God? I have three kids myself and I didn't have to make any special effort to show them there was a Lord of heaven and earth. They bought in instantly. It was as natural as breathing. Perhaps this is one of the reasons Jesus said: "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these" (Matthew 19:14). We see in these little ones a sense of the divine. They seem to instinctually know of God. It is good when we choose not to hinder them as they come to the God they naturally know.

Yet . . . hindering them is exactly what many choose to do. Many in our world today strive to teach our children out of faith. Secular colleges are notorious for harboring professors who have a personal mission to destroy their student's belief. Many of the world's elite mock faith. But isn't it interesting that no matter how hard wicked people fight against God faith just keeps bubbling up? Even in the harsh religious environment of places like China, Christianity just keeps on reemerging and growing. The wickedness of men cannot suppress the sense of the divine God's creations naturally have. "What may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them" (Romans 1:19).

Perhaps it has been a long time since you were a little child. Maybe since then you have been influenced by people who tried to talk you out of your faith. But you know the

truth. I know you do. Knowing of the One who gave us breath is as natural as breathing. "There is no wisdom, no insight, no plan that can succeed against the Lord" (Proverbs 21:30). My friends, the wisdom of this world is foolishness. It cannot overcome the Lord. And you know it! You've known it since you were a child. God has made the truth plain to you. If you do not allow forces of evil to discourage you then the kingdom of heaven will belong to such as you.
