Commit to Your Commitment in 2021

Saying you're going to do something is one thing. Doing that thing is another. I'm sure this comes as a shock to you – but people don't always do what they say they're going to do. Reasons for this vary. Sometimes it's because honesty wasn't the best policy. Other times it's because the person making the commitment didn't understand what was involved in what they were pledging to do. Some things aren't as easy as we expect them to be. What then? Do we give up? Some do – even on their commitment to their faith. "But since they have no root, they last only a short time. When trouble or persecution come because of the word, they quickly fall away" (Matthew 13:21). We can do better than that!

I want to thank all the people at Camden Avenue who have decided to commit to a spiritual goal this year. You heard the call to grow in your faith and you responded, even though many of you have been Christians for decades. Now comes the hard part. A commitment is made in a moment – usually in a strong spiritual moment, on a spiritual mountaintop. How will you live when you're down in the valleys? What you decided in a strong moment must be decided again in moments of weakness. Will you continue through trouble and persecution? For those who made a commitment for 2021, will you keep going until December ends? May God help your willing spirits even when the flesh is weak.

You took the first step. You made a decision to try. The goal you made can serve as a guiding star to show the direction you want to go. Keep making those steps. Keep trying – even if there are bad days and good days. If you're doing something good "do so more and more" (1 Thessalonians 4:10). I believe God blesses all the efforts that are made for Him.

- Loving God and recognizing more of His blessings, the blessings He sends my way and thanking Him for them.
- More Bible study.
- Read the Bible more, serve more, increase my prayer life. To reach out to show & share God's Love!
- Read the Bible through.
- Spending more time showing my kids, by example, how a Christian should live and act on a daily basis.
- Making sure my kids are prepared to make it to Heaven.
- Pray for Camden Avenue church family every day.
- Read through the Bible with the reading plan.
- Becoming a better listener: to God, to God's word, to my spouse, to people who may need an ear. I will
 also pray to become a better listener.
- Read the Bible through.
- Pray more often.
- Continue reading the Bible through each year.
- Being a better Christian example.
- Studying the Bible more.
- Showing my love of God to Him better.
- Finding my purpose in my service to God.
- Being a better person with a better attitude.
