

# Tonk Talk by Mark T. Tonkery

### Grumbling

"Do all things without grumbling or questing," says the apostle Paul. His reason? "That you may be blameless and innocent, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world..." (Phil. 2:15).

We are in danger of dissipating our energies on insignificant things like quarreling, faultfinding, disputing, grumbling, and questioning. If we are not careful we will spend ourselves in foolish debate and senseless controversy. We must watch out because God's purpose for our lives is something better and greater.

Halford E. Luccock observed, "Grumbling is more than a peccadillo, a somewhat unfortunate trait of personality. The habit of grumbling is a major sin, judged by what it does to character. It can spoil the whole climate of life."

And as Paul says, it doesn't set the right kind of example before "a crooked and perverse generation." He knew what Philippian society was like. It was morally warped and spiritually perverted. (Is our society any different?)

The Christian is placed in the midst of such environments - not to be conformed, but to transform by being light-bearers to such a generation. Our influence should be shining like the stars of heaven against the dark sky of surrounding sin - an impossibility if we give in to pouting, sulking, and grumbling.

How are we going to affect those around us? Will it be for good or bad?

# Doug's Discussion

### Ways that Work

I have to admit that I'm not particularly interested in practices and skills that don't work well. I don't want to spend hours learning how to tie a knot that won't stay tied. I'll pass on practicing cooking a dish that nobody likes. And you'll have to forgive me if I don't want to go to a training seminar for an evangelistic method that worked great in the fifties but has almost zero results today. If something doesn't work then why do it . . . am I right? I want to do things that are successful. I want to do things that lead to blessing instead of frustration.

That's why I'm so amazed at how interested the Israelites were in how the people of Canaan lived. God had to warn them "When you enter the land the Lord your God is giving you, do not learn to imitate the detestable ways of the nations there" (Deuteronomy 18:9). This was a warning that was often ignored. But why? Think about this for a minute. These nations of Canaan lived a certain way. They embraced idolatry, murder of children, promiscuity, and all kinds of other evil practices. And . . . they were blasted off the map. I guess the real question here is – how did those things work out for them? And why would you EV-ER want to do the things they did – considering what happened to them in the end? Wouldn't it be better to try something different – something that works? How about: "Observe therefore all the commands [God is] giving you today . . . so that you may live long in the land" (Deuteronomy 11:8-9).

I love that we have inside information on what works and what doesn't. Thank you God for your Word! Complaining? Doesn't work. Living for the things of this world? Doesn't work. Rebelling against God and going your own way? Spectacular failure at every turn. Listen – other people before us have tried all these things. And how did that work out

for them? Frustration and failure. No lasting legacy. Disgrace. Yeah, I'm not interested in any of that. That's why "Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked or stand in the way of sinners or sit in the seat of mockers. But his delight is in the law of the Lord, and on his law he meditates day and night" (Psalm 1:1-2). So no, don't bother asking about the ways that didn't work. Look into the Word and learn about the ways that do.
