# Doug's Díscussíon

## You Show Yourself Shrewd

Children sometimes have very different experiences with the same parents. One child may think that the mom and dad are wonderful, and feel truly blessed to have them. Another may feel the same mom and dad were so harsh they just couldn't wait to get out of the house. So, what gives? Unfortunately, it's possible that the parents really did play favorites. But, another very strong possibility is something one child wouldn't like to hear. It is at least possible that the experience you had with your parents was connected to your behavior. A well-behaved child will experience parenting much differently than a rebel.

As a father, I can say from experience that I love having fun with my kids. But, I can't be "fun dad" when someone isn't behaving. On those days (or at least in those moments), I have to be "stern dad." Now, the question is, does that mean I'm two different guys? Of course not! I am the same guy either way, my children are just experiencing me differently as a result of their behavior. May we all be wise enough to understand this concept! The temptation is to put all the blame on other people when relationships are strained. We may even say things like "you've changed!" But you might be wrong on that. They may be exactly who they have always been, you're just not treating them the same as you once did. The way you experience the relationship today may be different because you aren't acting the same way you did yesterday.

This concept even extends to how we experience God. Listen to these words of David as he speaks to God: "The Lord has rewarded me according to my righteousness, according to my cleanness in his sight. To the faithful you show yourself faithful, to the blameless you show yourself blameless, to the pure you show yourself pure, but to the crooked you show yourself shrewd (2 Samuel 22:25-27)." There is but one God. Even so, you could have two people who experience the One God in very different ways. A faithful person will have one kind of experience. A crooked person will have another. The reason isn't that God is different, it's because the BEHAVIOR is different. Carefully consider your deeds. Your interaction with God can depend on them.
