Doug's Discussion

Dare to Be Enthusiastic

The dark side of enthusiasm is disappointment. I notice this in the movie theater from time to time. For example, I was very excited to go see the movie A Wrinkle in Time, having read the book in school years ago. I remember being fascinated by the book as a child. The author was clearly religious, and the book played on themes of love versus hate and light versus darkness. I went into the theater with all that excitement and . . . walked out basically saying, "Bleh." All the things that made the book wonderful had been stripped away and they made it a message of self-belief. Excitement led to painful disappointment.





What's the solution here? The surefire way to avoid this kind of pain is to never get excited or passionate about anything. And I think this fear-based approach is the way many have chosen to live. Some even refrain from being excited about their own marriage! "Well, maybe it will work out, maybe it won't. We'll enjoy it while it lasts." Are you kidding? Have some hope! Have some excitement about your future together! But I think I get how this kind of mentality works. There is the fear of a future relationship failure, and if you don't get too excited in the first place then it won't be as painful if and when it happens. This, however, is a terrible way to go about life.

Listen instead to the call of Christian living in Matthew 5:12: "Rejoice and be glad, for your reward in heaven is great . . ." And Romans 12:11 says, "Do not be slothful in zeal, be fervent in spirit, serve the Lord." Christians are encouraged to discard fear-based living. After all, every promise given by God is a guarantee. Why not walk around excited about life and about the future? I encourage everyone in Christ to live with the hope that leads to zeal, to passionate, excited service. We live by faith instead of by fear. In this world of disappointed people that is sure to turn heads. Show them that there is still something to be excited about. Yes, I know you have been hurt be-



fore. Yes, I know there have been times when you expected good and only found evil. Are you going to let those experiences cause you to live the rest of your life afraid? Or are you going to faithfully find the joy of the Lord? One of these choices is better than the other.

<u>Not Fantasy Love</u>

There is a kind of pretend love that pictures the other person as what you want them to be. They may be Oscar the Grouch but you see a knight in shining armor because of some kind of fantasy infatuation. Sadly, a lot of affairs begin this way. "This person is so much better than my spouse." But you don't really know them. You think you do - but when the whole story is told people find out the grass isn't greener.

That's fantasy love. Real love is your spouse who knows you, who knows all your flaws. They know the mistakes you made - and they love you anyway. Real love is seeing someone as they are and loving that person, even when they're not who you want them to be.

That's what is so remarkable about God's love. Davis says in Psalm 139:1-2, "O Lord, you have searched me and you know me. . . you perceive me thoughts from afar." God knows everything. He can see every foolish thing we have ever done – and He loves us. He sacrificed for us unworthy people – so all our flaws can be washed away.

That's real love. May we all have love like that.
