

Doug's Discussion

Rejoice in the Lord

One of the reforms of King Hezekiah was to reinstate the celebration of the Passover. "It had not been celebrated in large numbers according to what was written" (2 Chronicles 30:5). I'm sure the people were celebrating something before this time. Maybe it was pagan holidays, human accomplishments, or even just the momentary pleasure of some sin. But now the king of Judah decided that they should all celebrate something holy. He sent messengers far and wide to invite people to this celebration, and many people repented of their previous focus and came. The Bible says that God heard the prayers offered here, "for their prayer reached heaven, his holy dwelling place" (30:27).

What do we choose to celebrate? I once spoke with another minister who lamented over what a Christian camp chose to celebrate at their end of the week awards celebration. According to him, there were multiple sports awards and one Bible award. Athletics are certainly part of the fun of church camp. But if that really was as lopsided a focus as that minister made it sound I wonder if someone might have been missing an opportunity to show young people the best kind of things to celebrate. What do you celebrate in your home? If Johnny comes home with ribbon because he did well in gym are you over the moon? Well, you should be. How about if Angie comes home with an "A" on her math test? Well, sure, celebrate that. And how about if little Todd shows you a Bible verse he read during study hall and wants to share because he really liked it and thinks he understands it now? How does your enthusiasm compare for that? If your excitement level just dropped off a cliff I wonder if you're missing an opportunity to show the young people in your house the best things to celebrate.

God has put many wonderful things in our lives, and I hope we enjoy every good thing. Sports. Positive, pure relationships. Good work done in school or in the workplace – these things can and should be celebrated. But above all these things rejoice in the Lord.

"Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!" (Philippians 4:4)
